

ACTION PROGRAM **GILMAN HOUSE**

DESCRIPTION:

The Action program residence is located at 98 Gilman Street in Portland. The residence has six individual bedrooms, two shared bathrooms, a common living room and kitchen, and has a first floor office area for staff. One bedroom and the lower bathroom are handicap accessible. Action Program residences provide housing to individuals who have specialized support needs around their housing and treatment. Basic safety, supervision of medication administration, and coordination of services with other ACTION Program services are also provided to tenants. This is transitional housing with a two year maximum length of stay.

STAFFING:

ACTION Program residences provide 24/7 staff coverage to the tenants.

RENTS AND FEES:

Contract rents are based on fair market rent guidelines. The current rent is \$425 a month. This includes room and food.

REFERRAL PROCESS:

Referral to ACTION Program residences is made through the ACTION Program at 106 Gilman St.

FUNDING:

Funding is provided through the Maine Department of Health and Human Services, MaineCare, tenant-based rent subsidies and tenant rent.
