Introduction

Shalom House opened its door in 1972 as the result of a committed group of community members coming together to create "a place halfway between." These individuals created a home in Portland for 15 adults living with mental illness. This home supported individuals in managing their illness and provided services that were not available elsewhere.

Since then, Shalom House has continued to provide this wrap-around support to adults with mental illness. We own and operate 27 properties where we house hundreds of individuals, provide access to clinicians, and meet the basic needs of those we serve. After more than 50 years, Shalom House has remained a social service leader in Maine.

The work of offering housing and clinical services is more pressing now than ever before, with homelessness and mental illness on the rise worldwide. We can do so much more together than we can do apart.

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About Our Work

Shalom House is a non-profit organization based in Portland, Maine, that cares for some of the most vulnerable people in our communities.

In 27 properties across Cumberland and York Counties, people living with severe mental illness are provided with quality, affordable housing, clinical services, and ongoing support from Shalom House staff members.

Shalom House also administers the Bridging Rental Assistance Program (BRAP) for the Maine Department of Health and Human Services. BRAP provides rental assistance to individuals with very low income who have severe and persistent mental illness and co-occurring disorders, and other disabilities.

Lastly, we offer the Shalom House Art Program to all adults in Maine living with a mental illness. This program allows individuals to seek art-as-therapy in an art studio designed to encourage creativity, process emotions, and create community.

Our services are intended to support individuals living with mental illness in staying stably housed, pursuing independence, and receiving a continuum of care that touches each part of their life. We serve over 1,000 people each year.
